### Terms and Conditions

- The Russell Agricultural Society reserves the right to accept or reject any exhibit. Spaces will be confirmed upon receipt of payment accompanied by a \$2,000,000 Certificate of Liability Insurance (see options attached) naming the Russell Agricultural Society as an additional insured.
- 2. The Curling Club will be open at 7:30 a.m. Friday for booth set up. All booths must be in place by 9:30 a.m. for opening to the public. No exhibits may be dismantled before our closing time (to be determined) without prior consent from the concessions committee.
- 3. Each exhibitor is responsible for obtaining his/her necessary vendor permits.
- 4. Upon request, 2 chairs and 1 table will be provided to each booth. All tables are to be covered to the floor and made as attractive as possible.
- 5. Electrical outlets are limited; please indicate on your application if you require electricity and, although power cannot be guaranteed, the committee will do it best to provide the service. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own extension cords.
- 6. All articles for sale must be clearly marked.
- 7. Based on the information provided in the application, the Russell Agricultural Society will make every effort to ensure that no two vendors of the same nature are located beside each other.
- 8. NO LASER PINS, LASER LIGHTS OR KNIVES allowed on the fairgrounds. These products are banned and their sale will not be permitted.
- 9. Vendors must not damage or deface any part of the fairgrounds or its buildings. The use of nails or paints on pavement are prohibited
- 10. All concessions must be manned at all times by their vendors or other qualified representatives. Vacant booths may be closed by committee members.
- 11. No pets of any kind are allowed on the fairgrounds or in the buildings. This policy does not apply to seeing eye dogs or animals brought in as part of an exhibit with the permission of the Russell Agricultural Society.
- 12. Every precaution will be taken to protect your property; however, the Russell Agricultural Society cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss of goods brought on the fairgrounds.
- 13. All vendors must adhere to public health and safety guidelines, including any COVID-19 requirements.
- 14. Upon acceptance of your application, the terms and conditions noted herein become part of the agreement between you, the exhibitor, and the Russell Agricultural Society.

Outside Curling Club -

Open minimum the same hours as inside the Curling Club. Due to Thursday evening events on the fairgrounds, outdoor concessions may wish to extend their hours.

## CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Russell Agricultural Society insurance policy does not extend coverage to any exhibits and requires all vendors to submit a Certificate of Insurance.

You must have adequate liability insurance with a **minimum \$2,000,000** coverage to protect the exhibitors, the attendees, the show organizers and yourself.

There are three (3) ways to arrange the required insurance.

**OPTION A: SINGLE EVENT INSURANCE:** We recommend using Duuo Insurance https://duuo.ca/vendor-insurance/. Vendors should select "Other Event", and use the information below:

**OPTION B: SINGLE EVENT INSURANCE:** The Russell Agricultural Society has appointed The Co-operators as the recommended insurance contractor for exhibitors. Please call Shawn at 1-888-712-2667 for more details.

#### **OPTION C: YOUR OWN INSURANCE COMPANY**

You can have your insurance company prepare a Certification of Insurance which must have the following:
